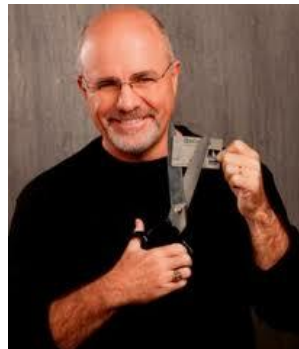
## Attention!

# HIGHER GROUND KID SPOT

## SUMMIT SEEKER VBS CAMPOUT IN REVIEW

God blessed us with a fun and exciting week with lots of opportunities to grow and He even included some celestial fireworks for us to enjoy. This year's campout focused on ascending in our relationships with Jesus by growing deeper with Him.

On Monday our theme was "Head" and we focused on the difference between head knowledge about God and knowledge of God. We looked at the apostle Paul and his knowledge about God and how he was still lost. We also looked at Psalm 131 and talked about pride and humility before God and how knowledge puffs up while love builds up.

Tuesday, "Hearing" and we looked at the apostle Paul and how he finally heard God's call on his life. For lesson we looked at Psalm 121 and the psalmist's need to listen to his companions reaffirmation of God's protection and love for him. It's important for us to learn to listen to God as we seek to grow with Him.

Wednesday had us focused on "Heart." For devotions we looked at Paul's heart change from persecuting the church to suffering for Jesus as he helped establish the church. We also looked at Psalm 126, a psalm of being restored before God.

Thursday we focused on "Hands" for service. The overflow of God's love in Paul's life was shown through his service and ministry. We also need to serve out of an overflow of God's love in us. For lesson we looked at Psalm 127 and focused on the importance of the builder of our lives being Jesus and not ourselves.

Each day we also had opportunities to explore our relationships with Jesus through times of contemplation, conversation, and journaling. For some the idea picturing Jesus beside us and talking to Him was tough, while others took to it really well. Be sure to ask the kids about their Drawing Near to God Journals which were filled with lots of fun interactive activities to help us draw nearer to Jesus.

In addition to growing deeper with Jesus through study, we also grew with Him and each other through games, free time, and hanging out. Each day was filled with lots of organized games, some with specific ties to the theme and others not. We also filled our time and got to know each other by swimming in the lake, learning to water-ski, kneeboard, or tube, playing on the water bouncer, hiking, snake hunting, fishing, making and eating smores, campfire fun and so much more.

I give praise to God for and thank the number of different staff who gave of their week to die to self and live for Christ as they let God work in them, through them, and around them. The campout would not be able to happen without the number of amazing servants who give of their time each year. Thank you for your willingness to serve through setting up and cleaning up, cooking, taking care of the littles, being a tent counselor, being a codirector, a life guard, nurse, boat driver, camp maintenance, worship leader, speaker, teacher, game director and so much more.

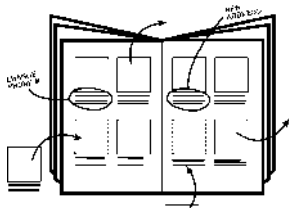
