Spiritual Warfare Study Starts Soon!

A four-week study on spiritual warfare is being offered at Highline Christian Church. It will be a study from a Christian perspective on the occult, Satanism, witchcraft and other various forms of the black arts.

The class will include an overview of the wide variety of cults ranging from the very extreme to more subtle groups. It will focus on groups that operate inside and outside the United States, including groups that operate in Washington State and in our own community. Some people may be surprised to learn that occult murders took place in our city of Burien a few years ago.

The purpose of this study is to inform the Christian community of what the enemy is doing right under our noses. It is not designed to scare anyone or to dwell on the morbid, but rather to remind the Christian that we are in a spiritual battle. This battle is fought using the weapon of scripture. We need to be reminded that the battle was already won when Jesus died on the cross and rose again. It is up to believers to take up the fight by studying the Word of God and doing what the scriptures say.

If you want to grow spiritually, please join us for this study. Do not let information from the first paragraph keep you from attending this class. The majority of the class will focus on dealing with day-to-day spiritual battles in our homes, neighborhoods and places of work.

Sal Dena, one of our members, will be teaching this class starting February 15, 2009 at 9 A.M. in the Chapel of the South Building. Sal Dena has owned and operated Sal Dena, Private Detective Inc. for 40 years. He has specialized in the areas of homicide, narcotics and criminal investigations. His main specialty field has been the area of ritual crimes (i.e. Satanism, witchcraft and other crimes related to the occult).

Among Sal's more notable cases are the Ted Bundy case, the Atlanta Child Murders and Gary Addison Taylor (killed over 200 women throughout the

United States). He was also consulted on the Jeffrey Dahmer and Son of Sam cases.

As a Christian investigator, Sal has worked for the Christian community nationwide and has appeared as a guest on "Focus on the Family" with Dr. James Dobson. He has also authored a book on spiritual warfare.

Sal has narrowed his investigations to working with police agencies and Christian ministries nationwide. He offers his consultation services at no charge to churches and Christian believers who have need in the area of spiritual warfare.
