Mission Trip Update Joplin, Missouri

Thank you for your prayers and donations for our whirlwind trip to help with the tornado damage in Joplin. Steve Moreland, Dave Sloan and Ben Kirkham drove straight thru to Joplin and helped construct a command center for the International Disaster Emergency Services(IDES.Org) a non profit Organization funded by the Christian Churches (like Highline) and The Churches of Christ Worldwide. Four Portable buildings were assembled, two buildings for showers, one for laundry and an office/sleeping quarters for the on site Director. The Center will be used during the construction of homes for victims not covered by Insurance. Project will last 2 to 3 years. After work is completed there, the building will be transported to the next disaster. All work will be done by volunteers. We praise God for a safe trip and safety during the construction. Energy, Stamina, Knowledge and Strength was provided by God as it was needed, it was truly amazing how God used us to his Glory during the trip. The folks of Joplin are a proud and amazingly strong group and were so thankful for the small bit we did to help in the rebuilding effort. Mount St. Helens Adventure

Would you like to visit Mt. St. Helens? A trip is being planned for Saturday, July 9th and it will be a full day of adventure.

When Mt. St. Helens erupted in 1980 the catastrophic blast rearranged several hundred square miles of the earth's surface beyond recognition in minutes, produced a river system in a day, deposited a hundred layers in hours creating a mini Grand canyon, carved canyons through rock in months and put to rest a myth perpetuated at Yellowstone for many years. Essentially, this evidence helps prove that the earth is thousands, not billions of years old, just as the Bible shows.

A PowerPoint presentation will share information that should strengthen our faith in God's word, and prepare us to give vital information to our family, friends and neighbors.

Our day will start at 7:15 A.M. when we gather, leaving promptly at 7:30. First we will visit the Seven Wonders Creation Museum for a presentation. Then we will proceed with Lloyd Anderson giving us a personal tour of pertinent stopping points on route to the mountain. We will eat lunch at a scenic spot (pray for a sunny day). At the top we will spend time at Johnston Ridge Observatory enjoying several activities. Our day will end with a guided walk – a two-hour walk

(slightly strenuous) or a flat, safer walk for adults and children. We will return at 7:15 P.M.. Plan to bring your own sack lunch and drinks. We will not stop for dinner, so bring snacks to eat on the way back to the church building.

Weather conditions have been cooler this year, so dress in layers for colder weather. If the weather does not turn warmer, a hat and gloves might be appreciated.

This trip is open to anyone interested in joining us. There will be a cost of \$12 for gas and entrance to the observatory. We are encouraged to give a donation to the museum. There is a bookstore with a variety of books and DVDs, including children's activities. Please use cash or checks for payment for your purchases.

Have you thanked an Elder lately?

The Elders of Highline Christian Church meet twice a month and hold additional meetings as needed. They are a sincere, dedicated group of Christians who were elected by the congregation to do the work of Elders. The Apostle Paul in his letter to Titus in chapter 1, verse 5 refers to Elders as overseers. Many people refer to Elders as the Spiritual Leaders in the church and rightfully so. They are biblically charged with being overseers of all the affairs of the congregation.

As part of their duties, they realized that a significant short fall existed between the income and the church budget. The budget is the program of the church expressed in dollars. The program of Highline Christian Church can not be carried out without the financial support of the members. During the past year, the Elders have considered all aspects of Christian Stewardship. No doubt they prayed, studied, discussed and then created an excellent "Statement on Giving". It is biblical, clearly stated and right in its conclusions. The "Statement" was published in the June eNewsletter. It would be wonderful and extremely helpful if every member of Highline Christian Church would study the "Statement" and read the referenced Bible passages.

A budget was presented to the Congregation on May 15 and 22 for a vote. The budget as presented is simply next year's program for Highline Christian Church expressed in dollars that are needed to carry out the program. As presented the budget/program takes in to account all of the ongoing activities of the church from the nursery, the staff, missions, giving, etc. plus the mortgage payments on the building.

Now the members of Highline Christian Church must decide how much each one of us will give to support the program of our church this coming year.

A suggestion would be for each one of us to talk to God and ask Him to guide us as we make our financial commitment to God and to Highline Christian Church, The living, growing body of Christ in Burien.. It may be that you are only able to give \$1.00 a week. Keep in mind that any money you give is given to God for His work. With God's help we should all be able to make a commitment and then systematically carry out our commitment. The Elders have led the way. Now it is up to us.

~Volunteer to help for the week of VBS

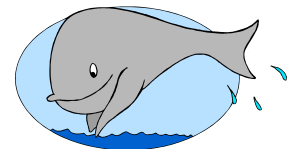
