Touching the World with Hope

BBC is located on a 16-acre campus at the Northwest edge of Boise, just south of the Boise River and only minutes from numerous opportunities for recreation, amusement, shopping and employment. The BBC campus is not only in a great location, it is continually being developed to accommodate a growing student body. How big will we get? That is in God's hands, but the college believes it will be blessed with over 500 students in the not too distant future.

Boise Bible College began in 1945, with just a few students as a ministry of the First Church of Christ in Boise as a training school for ministers in the Pacific

STUDENT PERSPECTIVE: *Natalie Barnes*

I learn most effectively through observing. During the past year and a half at BBC, what I have observed is passion. The staff and faculty demonstrate such astounding passion for God and His people. Their passion is often portrayed by intentionally pouring into students. One example comes through my role as a student leader. A significant part of being a leader is to serve others. Student leadership can often be overwhelming in the attempt to accomplish roles and responsibilities alone. However, God did not intend service to be powered by one's own strength. Rather, as Dr. Christensen often teaches, service is most effective when done out of the overflow. Instead of being drained while serving others, one must first be filled by God's love in order to pour into others most sufficiently. Living out of the overflow is accomplished through intentionally pursuing God's love. Those who have poured into me have done so intentionally, giving me the passion to do the same to others. The

staff and faculty exemplify this characteristic as they intentionally pour into students both in and outside the classroom. Their passion and intimate care is one of the sources that empowers me to be excited about serving my classmates. The dedication I observe in my fellow student leaders is astounding, as we push one another to serve our school to the best of our ability. I find beauty in the unifying fact that our empowerment comes from one source: God's love. Every thought, every word, every action is lived out with the purpose of serving others, being fueled by God's love.

No matter what you do, no matter where you go, may you always be fueled by the love of God to serve those around you.


Jerry had the 5 hour surgery Friday the 16th and it went well. We want to give the Lord praise and thanksgiving for what He has done. Psalm 103!

CAN TWO HEART BEATS CHANGE A LIFE?

In a recent, simple procedure at Valley Medical Center, a situation occurred that changed my life. They were taking a biopsy of my right kidney. Unfortunately, they nicked a blood vessel which resulted in excessive bleeding. One moment I was talking to the wonderful nurse, the next moment I knew nothing, I was unconscious. When I came to, I was informed that the wonderful nurse signaled “code blue” and begin to administer CPR. When I recovered consciousness, there were seven people including Dr. Bowen. Once things calmed down, I asked the nurse what had happened. She replied that as I lay there, I suddenly stopped breathing, my eyes rolled back in my head and my blood pressure dropped to 48. My End of life Directive instructs that if I quit breathing and my heart stops beating they are to let me go. A couple of heartbeats made the difference. I will be forever grateful and appreciative to the wonderful staff at Valley Medical Center for all of the remaining days of my life.

I am 91 years old, raised in church, have two college degrees and am passionate concerning the Bible and God. For years I believed I had everything figured out exactly “right.” Those few additional heartbeats have changed my entire life.

Don’t misunderstand, I am not afraid of dying, in fact I will embrace it as part of God’s plan.

Now “memories” from the past are vivid, clear and my belief in the Greatness of God is overwhelming. As a human being, I too have had suffering, pain and I am far, far from a perfect individual. Do I have regrets? **Yes!** Would I do things differently

now that I have had this experience? **Absolutely!**

Especially in my relationship with God and my fellow man. The greatest sorrow I would have in dying is the severing of my relationships with all the people who have been in my life and in my current life at HCC and at GenCare; The Lodge.

Has this event in my life changed my life?

For many years, an individual at HCC has troubled and frustrated me. I believed I had the absolute correct way of viewing and interpreting the Bible. I could never understand why the individual could not understand my point of view. Every time I met the individual, I was frustrated and disturbed. Now I look at that person, first as God’s beloved creation, and secondly as a very sincere, honest person. On a recent Sunday, I went up to the individual and expressed my new-found feelings for that person. I now see, talk and admire this person greatly.

Can two heart beats change a life? Absolutely yes!

The night before Jesus was betrayed and crucified, He was in the Garden of Gethsemane with His disciples. He prayed to God, (Matthew 26:39), “My Father, if there is any way, get me out of this. But please, not what I want. You, what do you want?” (The Message).

I do not believe Jesus was fearful of death, the cross, the ridicule that was ahead of Him.

The Conference will be held at **Warm Beach Christian Conference Center** in Stanwood on **April 27-29, 2018**.

Highline women have been attending this conference since the 1970's. The great thing about this conference is that we not only get to **worship and learn with women from all over Western Washington** and beyond, but we also have **time with just women from Highline** because we **carpool together**, we are **housed together**, and there is time on Saturday built right into the schedule for Highline women to have **quality time together** as a group.

The weekend consists of **four main sessions** with our main speaker **Joanne Kraft** (our enjoyed speaker from 2014), our choice of **four out of the 11 workshops** offered, **six meals** (Friday dinner-Sunday lunch), and **free time** to enjoy the outdoor activities, connect with other women, or even take a quick nap. 


A Wild Adventure Preschool VBS
