## ISRAEL 2012

Are you looking for ways to **bolster your faith** or to **gain a greater passion for God and His Word**? Would you welcome an experience that will bring **greater understanding to the truth of the Scriptures** and impact your outlook forever after? Would you like to **walk** today **where Jesus walked**? I encourage you to consider a study trip to the land imprinted with the footprints and faith of people in the pages of the Bible and the places where God interacted with men and women in human flesh.



Next summer (a mere 14 months from now!) several members of Highline Christian Church are planning to spend 3 weeks in Israel to participate in a field study on the Life and Times of Jesus through the instruction provided by Jerusalem University College. We invite you to consider taking this life-changing journey with us! The study journey begins in Jerusalem on July 2, lasting through July 15. The plan is to arrive in Jerusalem around June 30 and stay in Israel 5-7 days following the class to soak in the impact of what we have seen and heard, returning to Seattle around July 21.

Approximate cost of this trip will be about \$5,500 including airfare, the course itself and the remaining time spent in Israel. We will visit places like Caesarea, Nazareth, Mount of Beatitudes, Capernaum, Mount Tabor, Shechem, Qumran, Masada, Mount of Olives, Jerusalem, including sites like the Garden of Gethsemane, the Garden Tomb and many others.

If you are interested, we'd love to hear from you! On Sunday, May 22, there will be an informational meeting following second service for anyone who might be interested in learning more about this trip. Come and bring whatever questions you might have. Find out how you might make this "trip of a life-time" a reality!

## Encore Ministries

Encore Ministries, Highline’s outreach to our more experienced members ☺, will have a special presentation this month you won’t want to miss. Wednesday, May 4, Rev. Lloyd Anderson, director of the 7 Wonders Creation Museum near Mount St. Helens, will be with us to share a PowerPoint presentation to demonstrate how catastrophic processes during the eruptions in the 1980s rearranged several hundred square miles of the earth’s surface beyond recognition in minutes, produced a river system in a day, deposited a hundred layers in hours, carved canyons through rock in months and put to rest a myth perpetuated at Yellowstone National Park for many years. Essentially, he argues that this evidence helps prove that the earth is thousands, not billions of years old, just as the Bible shows.

This presentation will share material which should strengthen our faith in God’s word, and prepare us to give vital information to our friends, neighbors, and family.

## MIRACLES? TODAY?

Pastor Tim's sermon series on the Miracle of the Feeding of the 5000 was OUTSTANDING. He brought to our attention Christian principles for daily living that were in this recorded event and applied them to our lives today. I had read this account many times before and I thought only about the miracle and not what was happening to those who were there or what it meant to me.

The recorded account involved Jesus, Philip, Andrew, the boy with his lunch, the disciples who became servers, and the 5000. It affected ALL of them. Possibly all who heard Pastor Tim's sermons with the overall theme "Living for Jesus in the Moment," were affected.

Why am I writing about this today? The question came to me, "Is God Performing Miracles Today?" I Believe He IS. When an individual accepts Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior and seriously and consciously LIVES FOR HIM each moment of every day—"A MIRACLE" can take place in their life. Relationships between people are created and some are restored. Some habits and actions are discarded and new and better actions and habits take place. Attitudes are often changed completely bringing a sense of peace, satisfaction, and confidence to the believer.

How does this Miracle occur? When we truly and completely accept Jesus and we are determined to live for Him, Jesus sends His Holy Spirit into our lives to guide us, strengthen us, and fill us with love for God, for ourselves, and for those around us. There is a ripple effect that goes beyond ourselves. People around us will see the change in our lives and will usually respond positively to it.

The miracle in our life will also bring a desire to know more about God's will for our life. This can lead us into reading our Bible, joining study groups to learn and support each other, and express the "The Miracle" in our life by serving God through His Church as "God's Hands and Feet."

The following could be our prayer in response to "God's Miracle" in our life: Thank you, God, for the recorded account of the Miraculous Feeding of the 5000 by Jesus. Thank you, God, for Pastor Tim. Thank you, God, for this series of sermons that clearly showed the profound messages in this "Miracle Account". Our lives can only be more Christ-like after hearing these sermons. AMEN




