Just wanted to report back that the final overall weight for the clothing drive came in at 35,900 pounds (according to the clothes for the cause weight), for which we will receive \$7,355.

I calculated that the Sunday drive at Highline brought in 2,152 pounds, but we had individuals dropping off clothes separately at various times. That could easily have come to another 500 pounds or more.



## Seniors' October Progressive Potluck





## OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD



Highline will be participating in the Operation Christmas Child program again this year!

Empty boxes will be available beginning Sunday, **October 22**.

Filled and paid for boxes must be returned to Highline no later than **Sunday, November 12**.

I hope that you have been keeping your eyes open and shopping for items that would bless a needy child, but there is still time!

When looking for items to fill a shoebox, start with one main item that you think may "wow" the recipient. Then fill your box (provided box, any size shoe box, shoebox-sized plastic tote) with some of these appropriate items:

\*Something to write on: tablets, coloring books, journals

\*Something to write with: pencils (must be sharpened and include a sharpener), markers, crayons

\*Something to snuggle with: stuffed animal, doll, blanket

\*Something warm: socks, t-shirt, hats

\*Something for hygiene: toothbrush, comb, flashlight w/ batteries, soap in ziploc bag, washcloth

\*Something to play with: playdoh, ball, musical instrument, playing cards, jump ropes, toy cars

**NOTE: TWO BIG CHANGES THIS YEAR -- TOOTHPASTE AND CANDY MAY NOT BE INCLUDED!!!!**

### How To Pack A Shoebox:

a) Get a box at the church building on October 22 or provide your own shoebox or similar-sized tote

b) Fill the box (see above for ideas) or donate money for someone to shop for you

c) Label the box for Girl/Boy and choose age 2-4, 5-9, or 10-13

d) Pay \$9 to ship your box or pay for someone else's shipping costs (in increments of \$9).

e) Return filled boxes no later than November 12.

f) Pray for your box.

**NOTE: CHANGE THIS YEAR -- SHIPPING COST IS \$9 PER BOX!**

## **New Name and Logo**

**As you have likely already seen, we in the Children's ministry have changed our name. With the new name comes a new logo. The idea and heart behind "Ascension" is the journey of faith each of us must take. If our faith is a mountain, each of us make the choice everyday to let God transform us and take our faith to new heights! We ascend our mountain of faith as we follow our ascended king, Jesus.**

Post about what works for your family and encourage others on the page to try something new. There is no perfect way to do a family devotion. It doesn't even need to be as one group, individual devotions are just as valuable. The important thing is instilling the habit of keeping God's Word and His good news at the center of our life. If that isn't incentive enough, we are going to have a point system to help us work towards a collective reward. When you post a picture to the page, the students will get to put one marble in our jar for every person in the picture. When we fill up the jar, we are going to have a family party night. These events are going to look different every time we have one, but they will be a ton of fun. Having me as a friend on Facebook is another way for you to contact me if necessary. This of course is totally up to you!

## Rapha House

Rapha house is a Christian non-profit organization based out of Missouri whose mission is to end slavery in Cambodia. This organization rescues young boys and girls (the same age as our students) and brings them to one of their safe houses where they hear the Gospel on a daily basis and are taught skills and trades to prepare them for life after.

This coming year, all of the money that is given by our students will go to this organization. It is so important for our students to realize that the Good News of Jesus is so much bigger than our day to day routine. We need to look outside of our immediate context to see the needs of people around the world. I believe in the mission of this organization and what they are doing to advance the Gospel worldwide. To cheer on the students in their efforts to give, I issued a challenge. I told them that if as a ministry we can raise \$2666 by September 9th of 2018 (next years Fall Kick Off), that I would shave my head completely bald. 
