

Hallelujah - Praise the Lord

I recently experienced a time of intense waiting for something I really wanted, yet there were many details out of my control which would greatly affect what would happen. Finally, the day came and everything finally fell in place and praise the Lord what I was hoping for came to be. In that moment I was greatly relieved, filled with joy, ready to shout it out, cry, and so much more.

When was the last time you experienced something like this? What was it like waiting and holding to something so fragile you were afraid to hope for it?

I regularly pray using the Book of Common Prayer. During lent you do not pray the Hallelujah, it is saved for Easter morning and the rest of the year through. By not praying the Hallelujah it creates in you a sense of longing, of waiting, of hoping for something more.

I am reminded of the women on Easter Sunday hoping and longing as they approached the tomb only to find the stone rolled away. "Why do you seek the living among the dead?"

they are asked. (Luke 24) After the angel reminded all Jesus had taught them they returned to the disciples to tell them the good news, Jesus is alive! On hearing the news the disciples were not sure how to respond, it seemed too good to be true. They had a new hope, but it seemed almost too fragile to believe, even after inspecting the tomb they wondered, waited, hoped, and pondered.

Hallelujah, praise the Lord, Jesus appeared to them while they were still gathered in Jerusalem. All the anticipation, waiting, hoping had finally come to its fill and they could respond with joy, shouts of praise, crying, relief, and so much more.

This Easter, may you experience the joy of the resurrection and may it cause you to respond with praise that you would cry out "Hallelujah, praise the Lord!" not just on Easter morning but every day all the year through as we find our life in the risen Savior and King!


Summer Camp Opportunities!



Highline Christian Church is a partner with IDES – International Disaster and Emergency Services in their mission to meet the physical and spiritual needs of suffering people throughout the world.

Since its founding, IDES has carried out relief projects in more than 100 nations around the globe. Each year more than 200 projects in 30 to 35 nations have aided the poor, the sick, the hungry and the homeless. IDES seeks to help victims of both natural disasters and man-made disasters by providing for victims immediate basic needs and assisting them as they rebuild their lives.

This is the center of their mission and purpose.

Some of the relief efforts include hurricane, tornado, flood and aftermath of volcanic activity. Most recently they have partnered with churches in Texas to aid in the relief after the devastating winter storm that Texas experienced. IDES has also been active in COVID-19 response efforts.

To date IDES has provided aid for 34 countries. That's \$1,133,620 in relief with new projects coming in daily.

Please keep this vital mission in your prayers as there is always need around the world.


