

Making All Things New

Happy New Year and welcome to 2023! As we enter into this new year filled with all kinds of possibilities, it is good time to pause and reflect on the past year to give us insight into ways we've grown and areas we need to grow. Unfortunately, our spiritual formation in Christ does not happen automatically with the passing of time, it requires intentionality on our part to partner with Holy Spirit in the transformation process.

The Apostle Paul, in Romans 12 reminds us "I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. ² Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect."

Being a living sacrifice is the ongoing process of dying to self in order to live by the life of Jesus who lives in

you. What areas of your life did Holy Spirit invite you to die this last year where you were successful in following Him? As you reflect on the year to come, what areas of your life is Holy Spirit asking you to lay down to draw nearer to Jesus?

Our spiritual worship is a life lived loving God and loving others. As you reflect on the past year, how worshipful were your everyday moments? How did you do at following Jesus through your day instead of looking back on your day and hoping Jesus was with you? What is one main area of your life where you would like to see become regular spiritual worship, loving God and others?

Being conformed to something often happens from the outside in. The Apostle Paul warns us to not be conformed by the world. Thinking back on this year, how have you been more shaped by the world, popular opinion, social media, politics, or entertainment than by the Word of God? What is affecting you from the outside that is creating "thick spaces" between you and God? What do you gain by not letting those things go?

Instead of being conformed by the world, Paul tells us to be transformed to the mind of Christ. The Greek word for transformed is metanoia, we get the English word metamorphosis from this word. Another translation for metanoia is repent. Paul is telling us to repent of our selfish thinking, to be transformed in the way we think to the way Jesus showed

us how to think. What most influenced the way you think over the past year? What are your information feeds? How are your information feeds forming your mind and your life? What is Holy Spirit inviting you into in the new year with your thought life? What information feeds is Holy Spirit leading you to turn off? What is He leading you to spend time meditating on? In honest reflection how is your relationship with the written Word of God? What steps will you begin to take to allow the written Word permeate your mind?

As you reflect on 2022 and look forward to 2023, use the opportunity to invite Holy Spirit to reveal the places in your life where He is inviting you into making your life new in the new year. May it be a year of metamorphosis in your life as you seek to know Jesus more fully and to walk with Him moment by moment in your everyday life of loving God and others.

Next Gen Kids

2022 was a great year! Let's celebrate some of the things that God has done!

The Early Childhood Ministry has amazing volunteers who are sharing Jesus with the youngest Highliners! We have kids who are talking about Jesus at home. The children are hearing each week that they are loved by God and they are shown that Highline is a safe place for them to be. In June, our future kindergartners moved to Elementary to be welcomed with a special Bible. Early Childhood has studied the Fruits of the Spirit, forgiveness, and they learned how Jesus loves all of us.

The Elementary Ministry started in 2022 with a tiny group during the 9:00 service and it has grown to a group that sits down and studies God's Word together each week. We have a learning focus on who Jesus is. Kids are asking great questions, and thinking about what they have learned. The 9:00 kids have a passion for serving the Lord. They planned to support Operation Christmas Child and took time to make bracelets, keychains, and encouraging notes to be added into the boxes. They ended the year bringing coins to put towards serving God by helping buy golf balls for Pleasant Valley Christian Camp. We will start 2023 with collecting more coins so we can replace all the golf balls for the mini golf area. The 10:40 class has taken a walk through the Bible studying God's chosen people. We have responded to God in many ways this year! We have prayed, sat quietly to listen, wrote notes to God, read our Bibles, and worshiped through music. The Wednesday night group became 2 groups this year! We had the blessing of adding a program for Kindergarten through 2nd grade along with

our 3rd-6th Graders. The Wednesday night crew has become this sweet community of learners. They took a deep dive into God's Word. The older kids took the opportunity to practice creating a time to meditate on God's Word and memorize it in the last 2 months of the group.

Here are some of my favorite small moments this year:

- We had some kids decide they want to follow Jesus forever at camp
- Older kids served the younger kids at our VBS week
- We have a student that has been coming for 5 years and he is just now starting to join in for worship time.
- Kids are remembering God's Word
- The Elementary has some amazingly faithful volunteers. If anyone is absent, the kids notice and ask about it. The kids are building relationships with the volunteers.
- Older kids are stepping up to help the younger kids. They are being so kind and caring to make sure the younger students are seen and heard.
- Worship time has become really special. Students are requesting their favorite songs and asking their parents to find them at home too.
- The youth group on Wednesday night has joined us for worship, and we have joined them as well.
- Volunteers are empowering Kids to learn more about Jesus.

We are starting a New Year and I am looking forward to seeing what God will be doing in the lives of the families and the children of Highline.

THE WYCLIFFE MINISTRY OF Todd & Susan Smith

The Bible is one of the oldest and most popular books of all time. But is it just a book, or is it much more?

That's why Wycliffe Bible Translators exists — to help speakers of these remaining languages get the Bible for themselves. And we won't stop until all people have God's Word in a language they understand. Working toward this end, it takes many hands to make translations happen in any area of the world.

We at Highline Christian Church partner with Todd and Susan Smith in Papua New Guinea as they work as a support team to the translators.

The Smiths knew that God specifically called their family into global missions but didn't know how a construction



worker and an administrator could become missionaries. Through Wycliffe Bible Translators they found that they could become part of a team whose collective efforts enable the work of Bible Translation all over the world.

Todd and Susan along with their three sons (Andrew, Connor & Gavin) are excited to be back serving in support roles in Ukarumpa, Papua New Guinea. Todd is working with Construction & Maintenance while Susan is working at the Medical Clinic which provides medical care to ex-pat and national patients. The Smiths understand that Bible Translation takes a team. When you pray for or contribute financially to the work of Bible Translation, you become part of the team.

Please keep our Todd, Susan and their family in your prayers as they work to make the Gospel accessible to all peoples in Papua New Guinea.
