

Religion or Relationship

For most of my life I've heard the phrase Christianity is a relationship not a religion. It's a cute little phrase to help us quickly identify a huge difference in what we believe compared to what other religions believe. For most of my life I've believed this little phrase, yet if I'm totally honest with myself and others, I wasn't always sure what that really means practically speaking.

If Christianity is a relationship and not just another religion, then who do we have a relationship with and how do we have it? As a youth, and for years as an adult leading children's ministry, I was told and have told many others, our relationship is with Jesus our Savior and King. That's a wonderful and beautiful idea, but how? Well, the how I was told was by reading the Bible, prayer, and being involved in church life. Isn't that primarily what people in other religions do; read a book, pray or meditate, and be involved in whatever is going on? As I said, for years I've believed this little phrase, but have not always quite grasped what it

means for me in my life today, until recently.

I've been fortunate enough to have glimpses of what this relationship looks like over the years, yet more recently my relationship with the Triune God has blossomed in beautiful ways.

Our God is a god who is near. A prevalent false narrative is that God is distant, far above, aloof, sitting on His throne in some far away heaven above the heavens just watching and waiting for the time to bring judgement on the world. It's really hard to have a relationship with a god who is far away; long distant relationships never last long. The true narrative is that our God is a god who is near, right here, with us in the midst of everything we are going through in our everyday lives and He cares about what we are doing. More than just caring about what we are doing, God is already at work in the world and He is inviting us to join Him in what He is doing, He is actually choosing you right now to join Him to accomplish His work.

Our God is a god still speaking. We are in a relationship with a god who is alive and active and He is still speaking to us today. When I was younger I was often told God speaks to us through His Word and through prayer. This is true, God does speak to us through His written Word, the Bible, and through prayer, but relationally speaking, it was not until recently that I began to listen. I was taught to read the Bible and identify what it says and what it says I am supposed to do or not do, and that praying was

"easy, it's just talking with God." Well again, God is still speaking, the question is are we listening? God calls out to us through His creation. He expresses His love for us through the written Word, pointing us to Jesus who is His greatest expression of His love. And, just as when God appeared to Elijah, not in the fire, wind, or earthquake, but in the stillness, Holy Spirit still comes to us when we are still and ready to listen, when we can begin to hear His still, small voice.

Our God is a god of relationships. Father, Son, and Spirit have been in perfect community for eternity and they invite us into their beautiful dance of joyfully loving one another. Our heavenly Father longs to be in community with us and for us to experience relationship with Him. God is always at work in, through, and around us. Jesus often used the phrase "he who has ears to hear, let him hear," in other words, let those who are ready to listen and understand draw near and receive His words. We have been given the wonderful gift of Holy Spirit to dwell in us and to lead us in life, transformation, and the Kingdom of God. Too often I miss this which leads me back to the beginning, wondering what relationship looks like. But sometimes, when I am still, when I am listening, when I reflect on my day, I begin to hear, to see, and to understand how present God is with me, how much He cares, and How often He is speaking and leading me in His gentile, life-giving way.

We really do get to experience a relationship with Father, Son, and Spirit and it is beautiful and life giving. It's not always easy, life is not always perfect, I

don't always get what I want, but it is good because God is good. One thing I've incorporated into my life that has helped me most in experiencing God and this living relationship is introducing a regular practice of reflection and gratitude. Thinking back through the day with eyes to see how God was involved in my day has helped me to better develop ears to hear, eyes to see, and a heart better able to receive the relationship of my God who is near, still speaking, and ever drawing me deeper into relationship with Him.

May you have ears to hear the gentile initiation of our heavenly Father drawing you into deeper relationship with Him today.




Operation Christmas Child

Vista Missions April 2023 trip



Vista Missions is a SeaTac, WA based Christian non-profit serving primarily Latin America by hosting vision and dental clinics. Vista also sends glasses-

mostly readers-to ministry contacts in other countries around the world. Since its formation in 2007, Vista has given out more than 30,000 pairs of glasses. Recently, more than 500 pairs of glasses were given each to Ukraine and Niger. So when you place your used glasses in the donation box in the atrium you can be sure they will be used! Vista Missions is very grateful for the support of Highline Christian Church both financially and in donated glasses.

The most recent trip was to Mazatlan, Mexico serving at Estrella de Belen church. We did both a dental and vision clinic during that week we were there. The neighborhood where the church is located is known for violence so we all were told to be careful if we went outside the church. None of us felt any fear however as the safest place to be is in

God's hands. We did, however, face spiritual opposition. Our second day in clinic was started late as someone completely removed the electric meter from the outside wall and cut all the wires leaving the church completely without power. The Pastor and a few of the elders have experience with construction, renovation, and wiring so they were able to quickly make a workaround to restore power to the building. There were MANY people praying for such an outcome and the Lord was gracious to respond so quickly. We were only delayed by one hour! It was a great

testimony to the people of that neighborhood that there IS a God, and He answers prayers. There are many in that area who hold to pagan practices and "evil eye" jewelry was common. There is also a safe house for battered women and a drug rehab house for men in the area; some of whom were allowed to come to our clinic. Please pray for these beautiful, wounded and beloved children of God.

While in Mazatlan, we work alongside a local Christian non-profit called Shoulder to Shoulder. They are the organization who hosts, houses, feeds, and transports our team. They even have space for us to leave some of our trunks packed full of necessary supplies. They are also the ones who choose and partner with the local church in which we will work for several weeks before Vista arrives and they continue working with

them long after we leave. Their calling is to "serve and empower the local church" and if you would like more information about Shoulder to Shoulder and how you can be a part of what they are doing in Mexico, check out their website: www.stsmexico.org or find them on Facebook.

Vista also has supported and worked alongside a ministry called Roots and Wings. Some of you may be familiar with them as Highline as a church also

supports Roots and Wings financially. They are a family care program providing safe and affordable childcare and education to needy families living in Colonia Urias, right outside the Mazatlan city dump. Their mission is to keep families together and promote healing and healthy relationships. Since their opening in 2004, they have grown from a single story, primarily day care setting, to a 3 story education center offering fully accredited education programs to both children and adults, counseling, job training for parents and care givers, and addiction recovery programs. They have a child sponsorship program and other ways to get involved. For more information, head to their website: www.rootsandwingsim.org or find them on Facebook.
