One-Anothering

Have you ever noticed how often the term “one another” is used in the New Testament? With a quick google search I found a list which I have filter down to these:

Be at peace with each other. (Mark 9:50, Romans 12:16, 1 Peter 3:8) Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. (Romans 12:10) Honor one another above yourselves. (Romans 12:10) Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you. (Romans 15:7) Instruct one another. (Romans 15:14) Serve one another in love. (Galatians 5:13) Carry each other's burdens. (Galatians 6:2) Be patient, bearing with one another in love. (Ephesians 4:2) Be kind and compassionate to one another. (Ephesians 4:32) Speak to one another with psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs. (Ephesians 5:19) Admonish one another (Colossians 3:16) Encourage each other...” (1 Thessalonians 4:18, 5:11, Hebrews 3:13, 10:25) Spur one another on toward love and

good deeds.” (Hebrews 10:24) Offer hospitality to one

another without grumbling.” (1 Peter 4:9)
Love one another. (John 13:34,35,
15:12,17, Romans 13:8, 1 Peter 4:8, 1
John 3:11, 23, 4:7,11,12, 2 John 1:5)

There are more when you expand your search to include “each other” and “together,” my point is, one of the dominate messages of Jesus and the New Testament authors was we are in this together.

We can see this lived out in the first century church. They were an outlaw splinter of Judaism. They had nowhere to meet but in homes or in public. They had no religious book for guidance other than letters and stories from people who walked with Jesus. The man at the center of their faith ascended to heaven and they had no religious spokesperson just individuals telling stories of life change and council of followers that did their best to guide as they thought Jesus would want them too. They were a religion without religion.

This changed in 312 AD when Constantine had a vision in the sky of a cross along with the words, “In this sign, conquer.” He was on his way to victory at the Milvian Bridge outside Rome. He would later grant Christians the right to exercise their faith and not be persecuted. Emperor Theodosius would make Christianity the state religion in 380

AD and all the religious aspects, holy places, holy documents and holy spokes people were added in.

A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another. John 13:34-35

This is what I love about small groups. Small groups, where you serve, or study (grow), or do life together, emphasize this idea of “one anothering” in a way that the first century church did. This was how Jesus modeled life, he did life in a small group and in large groups. Sunday service is essential to bring people together and unify them, and small groups are where they grow spiritually and relationally.

Take a look at how you spend your time these days, hopefully you are in a group to serve others, a group to grow your faith with others and a group where you share the burdens and blessings of life with others. Not to add one more activity but to live as Jesus calls us to live.

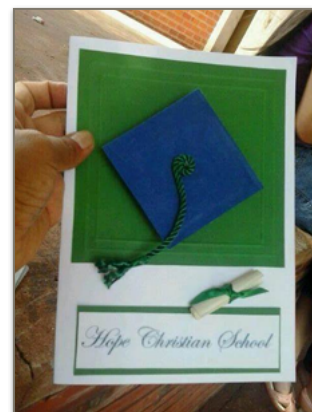


Hope Christian School is an evangelistic tool for the church to reach families of the students who attend. Many parents of the students have come to know the Lord through the association with the school.

Language & Software development

Danny & Ariel have PhD's in mathematics, postdoctoral experience with software development, and a passion for everyone to have a bible in their own language. Many languages without scripture are spoken oral cultures, some of which don't even have an alphabet. Software helps organize and check new translations of Biblical text, allowing translators to easily cross-reference with grammatically similar languages. For non-literate people in remote places, software enables distribution of audio Bibles on solar powered devices. The Rorabough's have joined Wycliffe as full-time software developers to support translators working in the field by making sure the software they need is available, reliable, and well maintained.

Go Strategic - Christian Worldview Discipleship

The School of Strategic Living (GoLife) began in the home of Dennis Peacocke with a vision to equip his children with tools that would help prepare them to be leaders in their generation. In 1991, this family exercise became what is now—the *School of Strategic Living*—and has developed into a course that has touched lives in the United States, Canada, New Zealand, Australia, and all over

Europe, and serves to further develop leaders of all ages. *GoLife* has proven itself an invaluable tool for those who believe God has called them for a purpose.

The school is a two-year program designed to transform leaders, both current and emerging, by equipping them to think biblically, challenging them to live strategically, and providing insights for leading effectively. Through our partnership with **CLST Global**, GoLife graduates can turn their learning experience into an Associates, Bachelors or even Masters in Theology degree with a concentration in Christian Worldview.

Results of the School:

- **Vision:** A sharply defined perspective for how to walk out a strategic lifestyle articulated by the Christian worldview
- **Worldview Foundations:** A complete framework, based on biblical assumptions, through which to interpret life.
- **Connection:** A process that helps to connect participants with other resources in a larger context fostering change and bringing transformation to one's personal life, family, business, and community.
- **Facilitation:** A trained facilitator who provides a level of direction to participants, encouraging and helping them to examine their thoughts, attitudes, and practices in light of the principles presented in the course.
